## BPA OF WNY HOLIDAY TOURNAMENT TOURNAMENT RULES 2022

1. Open to ALL youth bowlers. There will be eight (8) divisions as follows, and bowlers may enter and compete in only one division.

Prep Boys/Girls 11 years and under as of 8/1/22

Junior Boys/Girls Ages 12-14 as of 8/1/22

Senior Boys/Girls Handicap\* 18 years and under as of 8/1/22 - Average 200 or below Senior Boys/Girls Open\* 18 years and under as of 8/1/22 - No average required

The Top 8-point leaders in each Senior Division will be invited to a FREE tournament for a \$250.00 Scholarship in each division. \*Senior Divisions are open to boys and girls who are in high school or have not reached their 18th birthday before August 1st, 2022.

- 2. Handicap Division Handicap will be 90% based on the difference in average and 200. Senior open division is a scratch event.
- 3. Entering average will be the bowler's highest average from the following: a. Highest verifiable average from 2021 2022 bowling season, minimum of 12 games b. Highest current verifiable average, minimum of 12 games A copy of a current individual average sheet or standing sheet must accompany your event. Bowlers without an entering average must bowl scratch. All USBC youth members must have a USBC league average (Rule #319A). Non USBC members must have a verifiable league average (Rule #319B)
- 4. Qualifying Round & Finals All bowlers in the Prep and Junior divisions will bowl three (3) games. Senior division bowlers will bowl six (6) games, moving lanes after the first three (3) games. Pins do not carry over to the finals. No entry fee will be charged for the finals.
- 5. In the event of a tie in total pins during the qualifying round, all bowlers will advance to the finals. In the event of a tie during the finals, trophies will be duplicated, and scholarship will be divided equally.
- 6. Trophies/Awards Trophies will be awarded to the top three bowlers at the finals for all divisions. The winners of each of the four senior divisions will receive \$500.00 in scholarship. In the event of a tie for first place in all Senior Divisions, the scholarship will be divided equally among the bowlers tied. To be eligible for scholarship, all bowlers must bowl in a league or school program at a BPA of WNY member center or BPA sponsored travel league.
- 7. Bowlers must be USBC Youth Certified to qualify for the USBC Youth awards.
- 8. All Bowlers must wear suitable attire. Bowling shoes must be worn during competition.
- 9. Bowlers will not be permitted to smoke or vape during any part of the competition.
- 10. Walk-in entries are permitted only if space is available on the squad and the bowler checks in at least 30 minutes prior to the squad start time. Entries are limited on each squad and will be taken on a first come, first serve basis. Entries will be accepted by mail or in person at Town Edge Bowling. Phone reservations will be accepted starting December 1st, 2022.
- 11. Bowlers are allowed one re-entry in qualifying rounds, provided there are lanes available in a regularly scheduled squad. USBC Rules applied. NO NOTIFICATION WILL BE SENT UNLESS TIME REQUESTED IS UNAVAILABLE.
- 12. All decisions of the tournament manager are final unless an appeal is made in accordance with Rule 329
- 13. Bowlers and guests are not permitted to bring outside food or beverages into the center.
