ELIGIBILITY:

Bowlers must bowl in a member center of the Bowling Proprietors Association of WNY and have a verifiable average based on 21 games or more.

DIVISIONS:

There will be 6 separate divisions as follows:

Grades 5 & Under : Handicap Boys & Girls (Junior Event)

Grade 6 thru 8 : Handicap Boys & Girls (Junior Event)

Grades 9 thru 12 : Handicap Boys & Girls (Main Event)

Optional Scratch Scholarship Opportunities based on entries (Main Event)

ENTERING AVERAGE:

All bowlers will enter using their HIGHEST 2025-26 USBC Youth League Average for a minimum of 21 games.

TOURNAMENT RULES:

Squad will begin at the scheduled time. Late bowlers shall receive (0) score for missed frames

No changes will be made to lane assignments after they have been assigned

Only tournament officials, score monitors and tournament bowlers are allowed in the setee area.

All bowlers are expected to demonstrate good sportsmanship. Showboating or behavior that may distract or humiliate your fellow bowlers will NOT be tolerated and may result in disqualification.

All USBC rules will be observed.

The tournament Committee will decide all questions or disputes

Tournament results will be OFFICIAL in 24 hours

HANDICAP:

Handicap will be the 90% of the difference between the Bowler's average and 225

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

4 games will be bowled across 4 pairs of lanes moving one pair to the right.

The field will be cut to 1 out of 5

The field will be cut in half after each game during qualifying.

Lane assignments will be drawn after each cut.

SCHOLARSHIPS:

Scholarships will be awarded at a ratio of AT LEAST 1 in 10 in each division. The number of tournament entries in each division will determine the amount of scholarships. All scholarship money will be returned 100% to the bowlers. The funds will be held and managed by SMART.

All scholarships awarded will be placed in the recipient's SMART account within (30) days of the final date of competition

LANE COURTESY:

To maintain a consistent pace of play, all bowlers should observe a ONE lane courtesy and be ready to bowl when it is their turn.

ENTRY BREAKDOWN:

Entry Fee is \$50 (\$20 Lineage \$25 SMART fund, \$5 Expenses)

There will be an optional Scratch Division for an additional \$10 fee
